### DISTRICT OF THE YEAR

#### 1.0 **PURPOSE**

This award may be presented each year to a fire district.

- To provide a means of sharing information, innovative ideas and the variety of activities taking place throughout the state of Oregon.
- To give recognition to those in the fire service who have demonstrated progressive achievement.
- To benefit all fire districts, regardless of size, location, budget, or number of personnel.

#### 2.0 **SCOPE**

This Policy applies to all persons, directly or indirectly associated with the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

#### 3.0 **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

##### 3.1 Selection Criteria

- 3.1.1 The district shall submit a District of the Year form, provided by OFDDA.
- 3.1.2 The board shall establish a committee to review submitted forms and determine a recipient.
- 3.1.3 Form must be postmarked or received at the OFDDA office no later than two weeks before the award is to be presented.
- 3.1.4 Examples of activities that can be submitted, but not limited to are:
  - Innovative Program/Community Relation
  - New Public Education Program
  - Fire Sprinkler/Smoke Alarm Program
  - Handling Difficult Situations
  - Budget Crises
  - Personnel Losses
  - Volunteer Retention Program
- 3.1.5 Recipient must be a district that is currently a member of OFDDA.
