#### **Fire Service Memorial**

In memory of deceased fire service members, the State of Oregon, OFDDA and OFCA conduct a memorial service at the commencement of their annual joint conference.

- Any deceased Oregon Fire personnel may be memorialized.
- The application must include the deceased's name, rank, years of service, and department.
- The name of the person being remembered will be inscribed on a brass plate and will be added to the memorial plaque in the Fire Service Center.
- Applications must come from a fire service organization in Oregon and must include the details of why the person is to be memorialized.
