OFDDA POLICIES

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AMBASSADOR

1.0 **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this policy is to set guidelines for use of an Ambassador by the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

2.0 **SCOPE**

This policy applies to all persons directly or indirectly associated with the Oregon Fire District Directors Association.

3.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 3.1 The Ambassador
 - 3.1.1 Shall be appointed by the Board of Directors.
 - 3.1.2 Shall be familiar with the constitution, bylaws, policies, and have knowledge of how the Association operates.
 - 3.1.3. Shall not be a voting member of the board.
 - 3.1.4 Will not bind the Association in any matter, but will refer the matter to the Board of Directors.
 - 3.1.5 This position shall be reviewed yearly and can be terminated at any time at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.
 - 3.1.6 The Executive Board may authorize expenses when requested.
- 3.2 Duties of the Ambassador
 - 3.2.1 Attend all possible board meetings.
 - 3.2.2 Help promote the association and any programs that are in the interest of the Association.
 - 3.2.3 Act as liaison between districts and the Association.

Note: On September 26, 2009, the OFDDA Board of Directors, by consensus, agreed to VOID this policy. During discussions which included OFDDA's legal counsel, it was determined that the policy was not needed since the Board does not hav an Ambassador position.
